1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 21.02.2022 in CWP-2411-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 21.02.2022 reveals that CWP-2411-2022 was disposed of on the statement of learned State counsel that mutation would be entered within about three weeks.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states pursuant to notice issued to the respondent, needful has been done and mutation has been entered in the name of the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
