Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of promotion to the post of TGT English, w.e.f. 17.07.2018, i.e. the date when the employees junior to the petitioner were promoted to the said post.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the fact that the petitioner was fully eligible for the said promotion, she has not been extended the said benefit by the respondents, hence the respondents are under obligation to grant the benefit of promotion to the post of TGT English to the petitioner, w.e.f. 17.07.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the same grievance has also been raised by the petitioner before the respondents by serving legal notice dated 07.06.2022 (Annexure P-13), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to

respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 07.06.2022, by passing an

appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection, in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioner for deciding the legal notice dated 07.06.2022 (Annexure P-13) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in legal notice dated 07.06.2022 (Annexure P-13), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 07.06.2022 (Annexure P-13), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
