The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.220 dated 03.09.2021 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 466, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Reply by way of an affidavit dated 17.09.2022 of Sh. Jaspal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran has been filed in the Registry which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karnail Singh, submits that in pursuance of order dated 16.08.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated

16.08.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
