MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.234 dated 15.8.2021 under Section 323, 377, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal, Haryana.

Learned counsel submits that the FIR in question emanates from a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and his wife. He submits that a false case having been brought forth and the alleged injuries having been inflicted by the petitioner is falsified from the MLR of the complainant which was conducted soon after the occurrence in question. He has invited the attention of this court to Annexure P2, which is the MLR dated 15.08.2021 of the complainant, wherein only two injuries stand reflected which are as under:-

- “1. A red bluish contusion of size 3X2 CM present on the left arm shoulder.*
- 2. C/o Pain all over the body.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 10.09.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and co-operated during the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gurdev Singh does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation. She, on further instructions states that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 10.09.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
