The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or directions to the official respondents for the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a lady of the age of 27 years and she is aggrieved not only by her parents-in-law and their family but also from her own parents wherein she has a matrimonial dispute with her husband and her inlaws are constantly harassing her and at the same time the parents of the petitioner have also thrown her out since they cannot afford her and arrange for her second marriage and she being a lady is aggrieved by the action of her own relatives. He further submitted that the petitioner has given a representation Annexure P-3 to the Superintendent of Police, Jind in this

regard but no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents and states that he has no objection in case the representation of the petitioner is considered by the concerned authorities and is decided in accordance with law.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is a lady of the age of 27 years and her grievance is that she has been constantly subjected to threats and harassment at the hands of her in-laws and even her own parents and brother have not supported her and have thrown away from their house. The scope of the present petition is confined only to the extent of protection of life of the petitioner and does not in any way reflect the inter se relationship between the petitioner or any of the private respondents.

In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Jind to consider the representation Annexure P-3 filed by the petitioner and in case it is so required, then adequate steps be taken in this regard in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
