HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents are not issuing No Due Certificate to the petitioner on the ground that a sum of Rs.4,19,299/- is still due to the petitioner in respect of the loan which was taken from the respondent-Cooperative Society.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them a legal notice dated 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide

the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate order on the legal notice dated 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-3) will be passed by the department within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner subsists in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
