The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action against the respondents No.4 and 5 who are trying and making an attempt to forcibly take away the truck/vehicle bearing Registration No.PB-19M-9408.

Learned counsel for the private respondents has pointed out that the petitioner has moved an application to the effect that in the event of the loan account of the petitioner being rescheduled and settled, he shall withdraw the present petition. Learned counsel for the respondents No.4 and 5 further points out that the needful has already been done and the grievance of the petitioner stands redressed.

In view of the above statement, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to get the petition revived in case the above statement is found to be incorrect.
