Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.76 dated 01.12.2015, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of panchayati compromise dated 23.04.2019, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that although the matrimonial dispute was settled by virtue of compromise, Annexure P-2, but the same could not be given effect to. He seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh one in case there is any fresh settlement between the parties.
