CRM-M-37957 of 2021

Vide this petition, the petitioners seek the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.28, dated 27.02.2021, having been registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 452 and 379-B(2) of the IPC, read with Section 34 thereof (with Section 201 of the IPC added later).

Learned counsel for the petitioners points to not just the copy of the compromise deed as has been annexed as Annexure P-1 with the petition, but also to the aforesaid statement made before the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, stating therein that the matter has been compromised by the complainant with all the three petitioners herein and that she has in fact no objection to the FIR itself being quashed.

Mr. Jagjeet Singh, Advocate, appears for the complainant and also does not deny the factum of the compromise.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
