The petitioner herein seeks the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to submit the status-report regarding the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.60 dated 25.03.2022 registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC as well as Section 24 of the Immigration Act, before this Court and to arrest the accused and present the Challan against them in the competent Court.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Balkaran Singh from the afore-mentioned Police Station, he submits that respondents No.4 and 5 have moved an application before the police authorities and the inquiry is being conducted in respect of the same and the investigation

proceedings would be concluded in this case within six weeks.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn.
