Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.182 dated 26.08.2021, under Sections 376 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

This Court after hearing arguments at length of both the sides had granted interim protection to the petitioner and he was directed to join investigation vide order dated 10th September, 2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 10th September, 2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and duly complied with the terms and conditions of interim bail granted and as such, his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 10.09.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
