Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.104 dated 16.04.2019, registered for offences under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short "IPC"), {however, Section 376, IPC, and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (for short "POCSO Act") were added lateron}and charge under Section 376(2)(n), IPC, Section 6 of POCSO Act and Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B, IPC, was framed by the Trial Court, at Police Station Sohana, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the petition. He, however, submits that as the petitioner could not appear before the Trial Court due to a mis-communication and non-bailable warrants have been issued to secure his presence, the petitioner will surrender before the Trial Court on 06.08.2022, the date fixed, and file an application seeking regular bail, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

In case, the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court on 06.08.2022 and files an appropriate application, the Trial Court shall consider the same and pass order thereon as expeditiously as possible.

Petition is disposed of.
