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The matter has again been discussed with the learned counsel for the parties in detail and they have arrived at a settlement.

As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.21,50,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Dr. Shyama Arora Wd/o Dr. Vinod Arora, for & on behalf of both the appellants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.21,50,000/- favouring appellant No.1-Dr. Shyama Arora Wd/o Dr. Vinod Arora with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 10.10.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
