The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the reply dated 26.04.2022 (Annexure P-6), being violative of the provisions of Rule 41 of the CCS Pension Rules.

As per the record, the petitioner served the respondents from February, 1964 to June, 1972. Thereafter, the petitioner has approached this Court after about 47 years. The petition filed by the petitioner is suffering from extreme delay and laches. This Court does not find it appropriate to interfere in the matter.
