This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 for providing protection of life and liberty and security to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the present Criminal Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous as there is no threat of life and liberty to the petitioners and thus, prays that the present Criminal Writ Petition may kindly be disposed of as such. It is further submitted that however, in future, if there is any such threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then, liberty may kindly be granted to them to move a representation before respondent No.2 who may look into the same,

in accordance with law, after seeing the threat perceptions to the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

In case, in future, there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then, liberty is granted to the petitioners to move a representation before respondent No.2 on the aspect of protection of life and liberty and respondent No.2 would consider the same, in accordance with law.
