Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing order dated 04.12.2014 (Annexure P-5)& letter dated 05.01.2015 (Annexure P-7), whereby the petitioner has been relieved from the office of respondent No.2-Regional Transport Authority and was directed to report in the office of respondent No.1-Department of Transport. Petitioner also seeks quashing of order dated 15.01.2015 (Annexure P-8) whereby respondent No.1 has repatriated the petitioner to respondent No.3-Haryana State Electronics Development Corporation Limited (HARTRON) in view of his adverse conduct/work as reported by the O/o Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Gurgaon.

2. It transpires that during the pendency of the writ petition the petitioner has expired. Claim in the petition is to continue to serve in the respondent No.2-department is thus rendered infructuous. With regard to impleadment of LR and his appointment in place of the petitioner, needless to say, it is the discretion of the employer and the said relief cannot be claimed under extraordinary writ jurisdiction of this Court.

3. Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
