1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1.
2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 08.07.2020, reveals that CWP-9378-2020, was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into the matter and to dispose of representation/demand notice dated 21.04.2020, fully in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, expeditiously, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
3. Learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 13.09.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation/demand notice dated 21.04.2020. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 13.09.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
