This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-Commission to allow the petitioner to participate in the selection process and Interview-cum-Personality Test.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that pursuant to advertisement No.08/2015 dated 19.07.2015, for recruitment of Constable Male (General Duty), the petitioner had applied under the SC category. He submits that he had the necessary educational qualifications of matric and 10+2. It was the case of the petitioner herein that he had the necessary marks to be called for the interview in the said category, in which he had applied.

During the pendency of the proceedings in this Court, the result of the petitioner was produced in a sealed cover, which would reflect that he had secured total of 36.75 marks.

Learned State counsel would point out that the cut off for the last selected candidate in the SC category was 54.55 marks and, therefore, the question of inviting the petitioner for the interview-cum-personality test would not arise.

The instant matter is taken up for hearing today and in the light of the fact that the petitioner did not have necessary marks to be called for the interview, learned counsel for the petitioner herein does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
