This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 11.10.2012 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.1 vide which claim petition filed by the petitioners has been dismissed on the ground of limitation, illegally, arbitrarily and against the settled proposition of law, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

A perusal of the order passed by the Authority shows that the issue of justification for delay has duly been considered by the Authority. Except the self-serving statement of the petitioners, no cogent material was placed on record before the Authority to show sufficient cause for condonation of delay. It is also clear from the record that to sustain their claim and the plea qua justification for delay in filing the application before

the Competent Authority, the petitioners had claimed holding of a Panchayat, however, the petitioners failed to produce any material to show that any such Panchayat was ever held.

In view of the above, this Court does find any illegality or perversity with the order passed by the competent authority. The present petition is dismissed.
