Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR No.122 dated 6.4.2019 registered under Sections 363, 366 IPC (later on added Section 376 I.P.C) and Sections 3 and 4 of POCSO Act at Police Station, Phillaur, District Jalandhar. (Section 16 of POCSO Act was added while summoning order passed under Section 319 Cr.P.C.).

By virtue of the order dated 10.9.2021, the petitioners were directed to appear before the Trial Court within 10 days and on their appearance they were directed to be admitted to interim bail.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that in pursuance to the order dated 10.9.2021, the petitioners have appeared before the Trial Court within the stipulated period and have been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners have already appeared before the Trial Court and have

joined trial.

In view of the above, the order dated 10.9.2021, is made absolute and the petition stands allowed. The petitioners will continue to appear before the Trial Court during the trial.
