The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 76 dated 03.06.2021 registered under Sections 307, 379-B, 511, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act 1959, (Sections 307 and 379-B IPC along with Section 25 Arms Act deleted and Sections 392/427 IPC added in the challan) at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, district Rupnagar.

On 09.09.2021, this Court had passed the following order : -

“The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case at the behest of the complainant; the petitioner has no criminal antecedents; the petitioner was an employee of R.K.C. Company of which the complainant is also an employee; the company owed salaries to the petitioner and when he sought recovery thereof, Kulwant Singh fired at

and injured him; to cover up the attack on the petitioner the present FIR was lodged; DSP Anandpur Sahib conducted an inquiry and found the case against the petitioner to be false and that the petitioner is also ready and willing to join the investigation as and when called by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jagmohan S. Ghumman, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 27.10.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.76 dated 03.06.2021 registered under Sections 307, 379-B, 511, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (Sections 307 and 379-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act deleted and Section 392/427 IPC added in the challan) at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, district Rupnagar, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 09.09.2021 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
