Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that while passing the order dated 24.06.2022 (Annexure P-3), promotions have been made to the post of TGT (Hindi) but, the petitioner who was senior as per seniority list, has been ignored by the respondents and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is fully eligible for promotion to the post of TGT (Hindi) hence, the respondents are under an obligation to grant the petitioner promotion to the said post w.e.f the date employee junior to him has been promoted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the claim as being raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner with the respondents vide legal notice dated 27.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the said representation in a time

bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 27.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner on 27.06.2022 (Annexure P-5), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 27.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
