The petitioner has sought quashing of letter dated 09.11.2019 (Annexure P12) whereby his legal notice petitioner has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the legal notice of the petitioner has been decided without addressing the issues raised therein.

Heard. It is manifest from the perusal of the petition and the accompanying documents that the services of the petitioner, who was employed as a Tabla Player with Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (respondent No.1), had been terminated on account of misconduct. The termination had been challenged by the petitioner by preferring a writ petition bearing CWP No. 25044 of 2012, which was dismissed by this Court on 20.05.2014 (Annexure P8). The appeal thereagainst bearing LPA No. 1209 of 2014 was also dismissed on 07.10.2014 (Annexure P9). There does not seem to be any challenge to the

order/judgment passed in the LPA and, therefore, it has attained finality. The termination of the petitioner is being sought to be reopened by sending a legal notice. The matter has already attained finality, therefore, no interference is called for by this Court while exercising the writ jurisdiction.

Consequently, the petition being wholly devoid of any merit stands dismissed.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
