In compliance of the order dated 07th March, 2022, of this Court, status report by way of short affidavit of Baljit Singh, Superintendent, District Jail, Barnala, has been filed in Court today. Same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.

Learned State counsel while drawing the attention of this Court to the report of Medical Officer, which finds annexed as Annexure R-1 along with the status report, submits that the petitioner is not suffering from paralysis, as had been stated by the learned counsel for the petitioner on the last date of hearing, but he is suffering from paraesthesia, which is an orthopedic problem. It has also been submitted that the petitioner has been under regular treatment and has also been referred to Rajendra Hospital, Patiala on few occasions. Learned State counsel further submits that it also finds reflected in the report of the Medical Officer that the petitioner is recovering satisfactorily and his condition is being constantly monitored by

the Doctors concerned.

In the circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of interim bail to the petitioner on medical grounds. Needless to add that as per the undertaking also given by the learned State counsel in Court today, if and when the petitioner requires any medical treatment, he would be referred immediately to the nearest medical facility.

Petition stands dismissed accordingly.
