HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents have not released the pensionary benefits of the petitioner after her retirement.

Upon notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply wherein, the respondents have stated that all the pensionary benefits for which the petitioner is entitled for along with arrears have already been released to her. It has also been mentioned in the reply that the petitioner is already receiving the pension @ Rs.10,875/- per month.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing has been mentioned as to how the pensionary benefit of the petitioner has been calculated, hence, the petitioner intends to approach the respondents with the said grievance by filing appropriate representation.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State submits that in case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the fixation of the pensionary benefits including interest, the same will be informed to the petitioner in case, any such grievance is raised by the petitioner by filing any such representation within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach the respondents.
