[1] Application (CM-16747-CII-2022) is for preponing the date of hearing of the contempt petition from 04.01.2023 to today itself, while prayer in CM-16750-CII-2022 is for directing respondent No.3 to release the payment deposited by NHAI vide letter (Annexure R-1/1) dated 07.07.2022.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the applicants-petitioners states that payment as was deposited by NHAI vide Annexure R-1/1 dated 07.07.2022 with *Cala* has since been released to the petitioners as per entitlement, therefore, in the circumstances, the applicants-petitioners do not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of

learned counsel for the applicants-petitioners, the applications are *allowed*, date of hearing of the main case is preponed form 04.01.2023 to today itself and the contempt petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
