The petitioner herein prays for the issuance of direction to the respondents to look into the FIR bearing No.104 dated 20.04.2012 registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City, District Amritsar, under Sections 406, 506 and 34 IPC (wherein the offences under Sections 326, 323, 324, 379, 148 and 149 IPC are stated to have been added later-on) and to conclude the investigation in respect thereof in a time bound manner.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of all the respondents in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh from the above-said Police Station, he informs that the final police report shall be submitted in the competent Court within six weeks.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, it becomes explicit that the cause of action to proceed further with the instant petition does not survive any more in favour of the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed accordingly.
