The present petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to correct the date of birth of the petitioner from 29.05.1991 to 29.05.1999 in his passport issued on 26.06.2019 (Annexure P-6).

It is averred that the petitioner had applied for the aforesaid correction with the passport authority on the basis of birth certificate, Annexure P-1.

A perusal of the said birth certificate would show that the birth of the petitioner (29.05.1999) was registered on 30.05.1999.

Upon notice of motion, Additional Solicitor General of India accepted notice on behalf of the respondents and time was sought to respond.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the necessary correction has been carried out and passport bearing No.W6199334 has been

issued to the petitioner on 04.11.2022 with validity of 10 years, i.e. upto 03.11.2032.

It is further submitted that cause of action does not survive in the present petition and the same be disposed of accordingly. Learned counsel for the petitioner would state that in view of the statement made by learned Additional Solicitor General of India, no further orders are required to be passed in this case and he has no objection to the same being disposed of in view of the fact that passport has been issued to the petitioner.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
