As per allegations in the petition, petitioner No.1 is married with respondent No.4-Pankaj Kumar Yadav. However, they are having stained relations and now petitioner No.1 is living with petitioner No.2 and they are apprehending threats at the hands of respondent No.4 and in this regard, they gave representation dated 30.7.2022 (Annexure P-3) to the police authorities but they failed to take any action on the basis of the said representation. Counsel for the petitioners further submitted that he will be satisfied if necessary action is taken by the authorities on the basis of the aforesaid representation.

Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab appearing for the official respondents submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authority will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law.

In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to consider representation dated 30.7.2022 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law in case there is any threat perception to the petitioners.

However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 8 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
