This is an application filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case which is now stated to be listed for 08.07.2022 to an early date.

Notice in the application.

On advance notice, Mr. Sarabjit S. Cheema, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/State of Punjab and has submitted that he has no objection in case the present application

is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 08.07.2022 to today itself for final disposal.

In view of the aforesaid facts and no objection from the opposite side, the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 08.07.2022 to today and the same is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation of FIR No.228 dated 17.06.2021 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali to Central Bureau of Investigation and also to preserve the CCTV footage.

Learned State Counsel has referred to reply dated 30.01.2022, as per which, final report dated 20.10.2021 has been presented before the Court of competent jurisdiction on 10.12.2021 and the case is fixed for framing of the charges and thus, submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to take up all the points as raised in the present petition and available to her, at the relevant stage before the trial Court and also with liberty to move an application for preserving all the CCTV footage.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
