Perusal of the prayer clause of the writ petition would show that the claim was for protection of life and liberty of petitioners No.2 and 3 and direction to respondent No.4-Station House Officer, Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar to provide Police protection to them at the time of sowing of the crops as there was apprehension of breach of peace and danger to life.

In the reply which has been filed by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Rural) dated 17.10.2019, it has been said that the required protection has been granted and this finds mentioned in para No.3 of the preliminary submissions.

In the light of the above, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and therefore, the same stands disposed of

accordingly.

In view of the disposal of the main appeal, all pending civil miscellaneous applications also stand disposed of.
