Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.55 dated 20.06.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women, Sector-17, Chandigarh.

Vide order dated 12.10.2020 while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 12.10.2020, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 12.10.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
