[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-5, dated 17.05.2022, in CRM-M No.21000 of 2022 in case titled as '**Mukhtiar Singh** versus **State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CRM-M No.21000 of 2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide representation dated 02.05.2022 served by the petitioner by passing a speaking and reasoned order within 15 working days.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 08.06.2022, rejecting the representation. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge speaking order dated 08.06.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
