VINOD S. BHARDWAJ. J.

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) that has been filed by the petitioner, *inter alia*, amongst other reliefs.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.3 is directed to look into the representation submitted by the petitioner and is called upon to pass a reasoned speaking order thereupon.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P-4) and to pass an appropriate order in accordance with law after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months after the receipt of certified copy of this order.
