[1] At the outset, petitioner appearing in person states that his grievance is with regard to no decision having been taken on application, Annexure P/7 dated 27.07.2022 as has been filed in view of the decision of Hon'ble the Division Bench in CRA-D-152-DB of 2018 in case titled as Lakhbir Singh vs. State of Punjab and the trial is proceeding and is now fixed for 22.08.2022 and that in the circumstances, he would be satisfied if the instant petition is disposed of by directing the Court of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

[3]           Needless to mention, in case the petitioner appearing in person is aggrieved against the decision taken on the application, Annexure P/7 dated 27.07.2022, he would be at liberty to avail remedy in respect thereto in accordance with law.
