Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.303 dated 28.06.2022 registered under Section 15 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Dabwali District Sirsa..

As per the allegations appearing on the record the police apprehended co-accused Kuldeep Singh and recovered 4.100 Kg poppy-husk from him on 28.06.2022 and during investigation, it was found that the said poppy- husk was supplied by the present petitioner to co-accused Kuldeep Singh.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order of interim bail passed by this Court and that the petitioner is not involved in any another criminal case.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Ajit has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation.

of contraband and as such rigours of Section 37(1)(b) of NDPS Act are not applicable to the present case. Further, the petitioner is having no other criminal history and he has already joined for investigation with the police.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 02.08.2022 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
