The petitioners have the filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 146 dated 30.06.2020, registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC and later on added Sections 308, 325 IPC, at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deed dated 02.09.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that it is a version and cross-version case and that with the intervention of the respectable persons of the area, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos. 2 to 7 does not dispute the factum of compromise between the parties.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the paper-book.

Perusal of the documents would reveal that there are specific allegations in both cases i.e. version and cross-version and as per the allegations in the present case against Akash Joshi (petitioner No.1), he has given iron road blows on the head of Dharam Pal (respondent No.3) and on the left lower leg of Pushpa Devi (respondent No. 2) and on the head of Ranjana Kumari (respondent No.6).

Since there are specific allegations against the accused persons, no case is made out to grant the relief as prayed for.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
