The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.71 dated 8.5.2022 registered under Section 376 IPC at Police Station, Division No.2, Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 2.8.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 2.8.2022 petitioner has joined investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar has endorsed the fact that petitioner has joined investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.
