By this petition, the petitioner seeks a direction to respondents no. 1 to 3 to register a case on basis of a complaint dated 11.01.2022 (copy Annexure P-1), moved by him against respondents no.4 and 5, for the alleged commission of an offence of fraud and cheating.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ordinarily resident of Canada and he having purchased a Ford Endeavour car bearing no.CH-01-AA-0031, on July 22, 2020, he was assured by respondents no. 4 and 5 that they would get it transferred to his name. However, they subsequently got it transferred to the name of respondent no.4 with the petitioner actually having transferred the entire consideration to the said respondents for further paying the owner of the car on behalf of the petitioner (as contended).

He submits that since respondents no.4 and 5 are working as an ASI and a Constable in the Punjab Police, the UT Police is not taking any action in the matter.

Mr.J.S.Toor, APP, UT, Chandigarh, appears on an advance copy of the petition received and submits that a civil dispute is also pending between the parties.

Be that as it may, without making any comment on the actual merits of what has been contended hereinabove, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the SSP, UT, Chandigarh, to hear the petitioner (through his attorney) and to take action as would be warranted as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
