Present petition has been filed by the petitioners being aggrieved by the order dated 24.5.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by the trial Court whereby on their absence in the said Court, their bail bonds were ordered to be cancelled and they were summoned through warrants of arrest in criminal complaint titled as Raj Bala v. Saraswati Education and Management Society and another under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that absence of the petitioners before the trial Court on 24.5.2022 was not intentional.

Admittedly, offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act is bailable offence.

In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of without entering into the merits of the case with direction that the petitioners should appear before the trial Court within next 10 days and on their appearance, the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction subject to costs of ₹ 5000/- to be deposited with District Legal Services Authority, Panchkula.
