In the present case, the petitioner is seeking the benefit of service which the petitioner had rendered with the Sanatan Dharam Senior Secondary School, Jagadhri from 1973 till 1983 as a JBT Teacher. The only

objection which the respondents have raised in the present petition is that the petitioner was working in an aided institution for an aided post for which the major portion of the salary was being paid by the Government.

In one of the application filed by the petitioner, as per the information received under the RTI, the institute where the petitioner had worked i.e. Sanatan Dharam Senior Secondary School, Jagadhri, is not an aided institution post 2018 but nothing has come on record whether, prior to the said date when the petitioner was discharging his duties, the post on which the petitioner was working was an aided post or not.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in case the petitioner places on record any document to show his entitlement keeping in view the provisions envisaged under the rules or the settled principle of law for counting the service rendered by the petitioner in Sanatan Dharam Senior Secondary School, Jagadhri, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate decision will be taken within a period of eight weeks if any such claim is made by the petitioner by attaching the required proof.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach the respondents with appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
