1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.01.2021 in CRWP-810-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 28.01.2021 reveals that CRWP-810-2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to look into representation dated 21.12.2020 and take appropriate steps/action, if any, required in accordance with law.

3. Pursuant to notice issued, learned State counsel has filed reply alongwith Annexure R-2 i.e. report of Superintendent of Police Traffic Patiala. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner on perusal of the same states that in view of the report Annexure R-2 dated 17.02.2021, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge the consigning of his representation dated 21.12.2020 to the record room

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
