[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 21.03.2022, in CWP No.5502 of 2022 in case titled as '**Ajit Singh versus State of Punjab and others.**

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 21.03.2022, reveals that CWP No.5502 of 2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim made in legal notice dated 27.08.2021 filed by the petitioner within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Although, notice has yet not been issued in the instant case learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has produced a copy of speaking order dated 24.04.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been rejected, the petitioner

does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge speaking order dated 24.04.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
