The petitioner herein has made a prayer to call for the entire record from the office of respondents No.3 and 4 regarding the steps taken and the investigation conducted in respect of the FIR bearing No.427 dated 25.05.2022 registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, under Sections 323, 34, 341 and 506 IPC and also to direct the respondents to take appropriate action in the above-said criminal case.

Mr. Apoorv Garg, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of all the respondents in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from HC Pushpendra Kumar from the afore-said Police Station, he apprises the Court that the investigation has been concluded in the said case wherein the allegations, as levelled by the petitioner in the subject FIR, have been found to be false and the cancellation report has also been prepared accordingly and the

same would be submitted in the Court shortly.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, it becomes explicit that the cause of action to pursue this petition further does not survive any more in favour of the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed accordingly.
