Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.0026 dated 12.03.2020, registered for offences under Sections 294, 376, 406, 498-A, 506 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Women, Karnal, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of complainant's affidavit dated 17.07.2020, Annexure P-2.

Although, the petition has been filed seeking quashing of an FIR, which has arisen out of a matrimonial dispute, statements of the parties have been recorded and a report has been received from the Trial Court, but by referring to the application (CRM-1597-2021), counsel for the complainant-respondent No.3 is opposing the prayer made in the petition. He has categorically submitted that after the compromise, the petitioner has been intimidating the complainant and even an FIR has been registered. Reference has been made to para 11 of her affidavit, Annexure P-2.

In view of the above, prayer made in the petition cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
