The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.13 dated
09.01.2021, under Sections 302 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station
Kotwali, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present
case, although there are 20 witnesses, out of which, one has been
examined and one has been given up, but the complainant has not been
examined as yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some
time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at

this stage, with liberty to file fresh petition after the complainant in the present case is examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for, with liberty to file fresh petition after the complainant is examined.

It is made clear that the second petition for regular bail, if any filed by the petitioner, would be considered independently on its merit, in accordance with law.
