Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuing direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to conduct fair, impartial and expeditious investigation/action on the repeated complaints given by the petitioner.

Notice of motion was issued on 10.09.2021. Learned State counsel had accepted the notice. In pursuance thereof, a short reply by way of affidavit dated 16.08.2022 has been filed by Shri Sanjeev Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ajnala, Amritsar-Rural. The relevant paragraph of the said affidavit is reproduced as under:

“8. That it is respectfully submitted that keeping in view the totality of the facts and submissions made hereinabove, it is evident that a detailed enquiry into the applications/representations (Annexure P/4 to P/7) given by the petitioner was conducted in a fair, impartial and expeditious manner, but the allegations levelled therein were not substantiated, hence, the same have been filed and consigned to record. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.”

In view of the said para, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this case has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
