By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to respondent No. 4 to grant him emergency parole for eight weeks in view of Section 3(1)(a) of The Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 to attend his ailing father.

Learned counsel for the State has filed report by way of supplementary affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Baghapurana, District Moga, dated 15.01.2022 in Court today and the same is taken on record.

As per the said report, enquiry has been conducted by the local police with regard to other family members of the petitioner. On 03.01.2022, ASI Gurnaib Singh visited the native place of the petitioner at village Cheeda and joined Jagroop Singh, Member Panchayat, Cheeda and recorded his statement (Annexure R-3/T). As per the said statement (Annexure R-3/T), the petitioner has total 4 siblings (including him). Besides petitioner, his father Mangal Singh

has one son namely Jaskaran Singh and two daughters namely Jaspreet Kaur and Prabhjot Kaur. Jaspreet Kaur, sister of the petitioner is married and living with her family in England. His one brother Jaskaran Singh and one sister Prabhjot Kaur are still unmarried and his father Mangal Singh is being looked after and maintained by them.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

He is allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
