The present writ petition has been filed by Gurmel Singh who is the father of Gurdial Singh. Gurdial Singh has applied for re-issuance of the passport, but the application has been rejected on the ground of pendency of proclaimed offender proceedings

The writ petition is liable to be dismissed on the short ground of maintainability as the father cannot espouse the case of his son who is a major. Even on merits, the passport authorities were justified in refusing re-issuance of passport as admittedly, proclaimed offender proceedings are pending.

In view of above, the writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
