GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.16 dated 05.01.2022 at Police Station Sector 32-33, Karnal, under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, wherein the allegations in nutshell are that the petitioner was found in possession of 120 grams of 'charas'.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and that in any case the recovered contraband would fall in the category of 'intermediate quantity' and as such, the petitioner deserves the concession of bail.
3. Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact that the recovered contraband would fall in the category of 'intermediate quantity'. Learned State has informed that the petitioner as on date has been behind bars

since the last about 9 months and that as on date charges have not been framed.

4. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner has been behind bars for a substantial period of about 9 months and that trial has not even commenced inasmuch as charges have not been framed so far and that the petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case, further detention of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose as the conclusion of trial will take some time. The petition, as such, is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
